



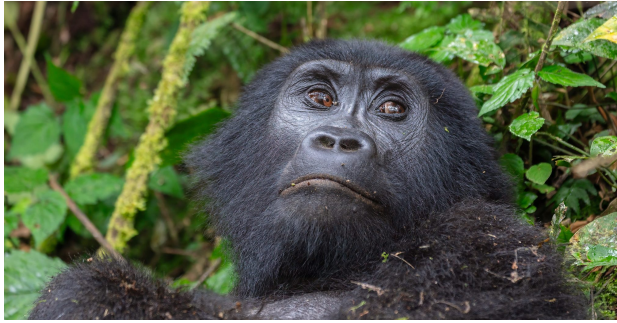

Three countries, two kinds of wild

Seventeen days across East Africa, built around two very different experiences. The first eleven take in the classic savannah — the Masai Mara, Lake Nakuru and Amboseli in Kenya, then over the Namanga border into Tanzania for Tarangire, the Serengeti and the Ngorongoro Crater. The last six move into the forests of south-western Uganda, where the plains give way to montane rainforest and an hour in the company of a mountain gorilla family in Bwindi.

Day 1 to Day 5



DAY 1

Masai Mara National Reserve

Transfer to the Masai Mara National Reserve and an afternoon game drive across the open grassland that gives the reserve its name.

OVERNIGHT MARA SOPA LODGE

DAY 2

Masai Mara National Reserve

A full day of game drives in the Masai Mara. Predator density here is among the highest recorded anywhere in Africa, and the open terrain means you see a great deal of it.

OVERNIGHT MARA SOPA LODGE

DAY 3

Lake Nakuru National Park

Transfer to Lake Nakuru National Park in the Great Rift Valley, with game drives on arrival. Known for its flamingos and as one of Kenya's most reliable rhino sanctuaries.

OVERNIGHT LAKE NAKURU SOPA LODGE

DAY 4

Amboseli National Park

A morning game drive, then the transfer to Amboseli — famous for large elephant herds framed against Kilimanjaro. The afternoon is free to settle in at the lodge.

OVERNIGHT AMBOSELI SOPA LODGE

DAY 5

Amboseli National Park

A full day of game drives in Amboseli. On clear mornings Kilimanjaro rises directly behind the herds.

Day 6 to Day 11



DAY 6 **Namanga Border — Arusha**

A morning game drive, then the drive south to the Namanga border post, crossing into Tanzania and continuing to Arusha at the foot of Mount Meru.

OVERNIGHT PAZURI INN

DAY 7 **Tarangire National Park**

Transfer to Tarangire for game drives. Tarangire holds the densest elephant population in northern Tanzania, moving between ancient baobabs along the river.

OVERNIGHT BOUGAINVILLEA SAFARI LODGE, KARATU

DAY 8 **Central Serengeti**

Into the Central Serengeti with game drives en route. The Seronera area holds resident lion prides and some of the highest leopard densities on the continent.

OVERNIGHT SERENGETI TENTED CAMP

DAY 9 **North Serengeti — Mara River**

North to the Mara River country with game drives. Between roughly July and October the migration crosses and re-crosses the river here.

OVERNIGHT SERENGETI TENTED CAMP

DAY 10 **Central Serengeti**

A morning game drive in the north, then the transfer back to the Central Serengeti with further game viewing along the way.

OVERNIGHT SERENGETI TENTED CAMP

DAY 11 **Ngorongoro Crater**

Transfer to the Ngorongoro Crater and descend for a game drive on the crater floor — 260 square kilometres holding one of the densest concentrations of wildlife in Africa.

OVERNIGHT BOUGAINVILLEA SAFARI LODGE, KARATU

Day 12 to Day 17



DAY 12 Kilimanjaro — Entebbe

Transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport for the flight to Entebbe, arriving in Uganda for an overnight on the shore of Lake Victoria.

OVERNIGHT 2 FRIENDS BEACH HOTEL

DAY 13 Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

South-west to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park — montane rainforest on the edge of the Albertine Rift, home to roughly half the world's remaining mountain gorillas.

OVERNIGHT GORILLA MIST CAMP

DAY 14 Gorilla Trekking — Bwindi

An early start with rangers and trackers to find a habituated gorilla family, then one hour in their company. The walk can take from one to several hours over steep, forested ground. The afternoon brings a cultural visit with the Batwa community.

OVERNIGHT GORILLA MIST CAMP

DAY 15 Lake Bunyonyi

Transfer to Lake Bunyonyi, a deep crater lake scattered with steep green islands, for a boat ride on the water.

OVERNIGHT BUNYONYI SAFARIS LODGE

DAY 16 Lake Mburo National Park

Transfer to Lake Mburo for game drives and a boat safari. Uganda's smallest savannah park and the only one holding impala and eland, with hippo and crocodile along the shore.

OVERNIGHT LEOPARD REST CAMP

DAY 17 Entebbe — Departure

Transfer to Entebbe International Airport for your onward departure.
